Also the points were given for each run separately (50 points for the winner of each run), so that total points don't refer to the winner's time of 111.0 seconds, but to the combined winning times of both runs (110 seconds). Still without nowadays computers, officials were struggling in getting the figures right.

If the data for both runs were reproduced correctly, the proper outcome should have been as follows:
